Remembering our Youths

2 Tim 2:22

So flee youthful passions and pursue righteousness, faith, love, and peace, along with those who call on the Lord from a pure heart. ESV

These words were written about 2000 years ago by the apostle Paul to his dear son in the faith Timothy. This instruction was important to Timothy during his day, but is even more important to our youths considering what is happening today. Our young people are growing up in a world that is exceedingly evil and thus the temptation not to stand for the truth and righteousness is very great. There are two things that can be highlighted in the verse.

The first one being from what the young person must flee from – the youthful passions! Today many young people aspire the kind of life that celebrities portray with the wealth and the finery of life. Unfortunately, this kind of life to a great extent also involves vices that are against the Word of God such as sexual sins, drunkenness, drug abuse etc. The apostle urges Timothy not to give in to these temptations as a child of God. These passions can be very strong that it would require enormous effort to overcome them, therefore Paul instructs Timothy – FLEE!

The second thing that Paul addresses is where the youth must flee to. It is important to note that the youth should not just flee from danger, BUT towards a safe place where there is righteousness, faith, love and peace. Furthermore, it is clear that the youth cannot do this on his own; he or she needs the help of all who call upon the Lord from a pure heart. All the adults in the church have a part to play in the lives of young people. Remember the vow that the church make during the dedications of children—that we shall help in the raising of the children?

For this reason, we would like to highlight the issues of our young people during the month of February. We encourage all the church members to set aside time to pray for the young people in their personal prayer times. We shall be spending a few minutes during Morning and Evening Services to remember them before our Father in heaven.
