2. The School background and its growth over the years.

Background: Nkana East Chapel Primary School is one of the church ministries of Nkana East Chapel. In 2000 – 2001 the church was convinced to use education to reach children and their parents with the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ.

It's growth: The School has improved in it's enrolment in the past five years. The school has gained it's popularity in Nkana East, West, Ndeke and surrounding areas. In 2013, the school became an examination center for grade (7) seven composite exams.
