Mrs Exildah Kalunga Kalande, Acting Head Teacher, is very delighted with the School's progress. At the time she joined the teaching staff ten years ago, there were just a few pupils from Baby Class to Grade 7 (10 pupils per class on average). Few parents were interested in the School.

The teaching team and the Church prayed for more parents to get interested in the School so that more children could access quality education based on Christian character. "God has answered our prayers", says Mrs Kalande with joy. "Since its inception, each Grade 7 class has performed exceptionally well, achieving 100% pass in examinations. All the classes are now enrolled to full capacity. The teaching staff are creative and dedicated, enabling the pupils to enjoy their lessons. The Lord has been gracious". She is also happy with the parents' support to the teaching staff: "We very much appreciate their cooperation. For example, when we ask them to help out with the school events, they willingly bring their children. Right now they are looking forward to take part in the School's Independence Celebrations.
